Please note: FAR Part 61 requires 40 hours of simulated or actual instrument training (which can include up to 20 hours in an approved simulator) to be eligible for the practical test. We have quoted 45 hours since we can not count taxi, takeoff, and landing time. An additional requirement for eligibility under part 61 is 50 hours of cross country PIC time.
