Private Pilot License (FAR Part 141)

Please note: The FAA requires a minimum of 35 hours of flight training to obtain a Private Pilot License through FAR Part 141, however, the national average is 72 hours of training to proficiency. A typical Ace Pilot student is able to complete training in 60 hours, therefore, the price calculation below reflects an estimated training cost based on 60 hours. Some students may complete their training in less than 60 hours and some will require more than 60 hours.
