Instrument Rating (FAR Part 61)

Prerequisite: Private Pilot Certificate

Please note: The FAA requires a minimum of 40 hours of simulated flight training, actual instrument conditions, or SIM training (not to exceed 20 hours) to obtain an Instrument Rating through FAR Part 61. Students should figure an additional 5 hours of flight time to cover time spent for taxi, takeoff, and landing as the 40 required hours must be simulated instrument time. An additional prerequisite of 50 hours of cross country PIC time is also required to be eligible for the practical test.
