Private Pilot Certificate (FAR Part 141)

Please note: The FAA requires a minimum of 35 hours of flight training to obtain a Private Pilot Certificate through FAR Part 141, however, the national average is 72 hours of training to proficiency. A typical Ace Pilot student is able to complete training in 60 hours, therefore, the price calculation below reflects both the FAA minimum time and an estimated training cost based on 60 hours.
