Private Pilot Certificate (FAR Part 61)

Please note: The FAA requires a minimum of 40 hours of flight training to obtain a Private Pilot Certificate through FAR Part 61, however, the national average is 72 hours of training to proficiency. A typical Ace Pilot student is able to complete training in 65 hours, therefore, the price calculation below reflects both the FAA minimum time and an estimated training cost based on 65 hours. Some students may be able to complete their training in less than 65 hours and some will require more than 65 hours.
