Private Pilot Certificate (FAR Part 61)

Please note: The FAA requires a minimum of 40 hours of flight training to obtain a Private Pilot License through FAR Part 61, however, this is unrealistic and most students will require closer to 65 hours to train to proficiency. We are providing the cost for completing the course in the minimum time of 40 hours as well as the more typical time of 65 hours. The cost will almost certainly be between these two numbers.
